WELCOME

We are glad that you have chosen to attend Crosswinds Church this weekend. The season leading up to Easter is commonly called "Lent," a word which originally referred to the spring season. Lent is typically forty days long, based on the forty days Jesus spent in the wilderness prior to his public ministry. Lent is a time for reflection, prayer and penitence—all looking forward to the victory of Easter.

Luke's Gospel describes Jesus as on a mission - a mission to get to Jerusalem to face the greatest challenge of his life. This was a very painful journey for Jesus, but one that brings us great hope. In the next few weeks we will travel together on *A Journey toward Wholeness*.

Today, Eric Weaver shares a message called "Crucified with Christ." Paul told the believers in the region of Galatia that he had been "crucified with Christ!" What did Paul mean by that? What does it mean for us today? In this message we'll wrestle with this provocative language and discover the real power that is available to us through the resurrection of Jesus.
